Please can each family provide either a cake for the cake raffle or a slice or muffins to sell on the day.

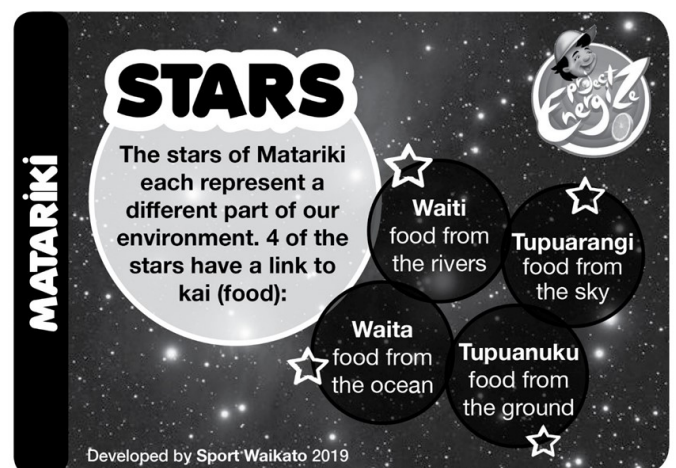
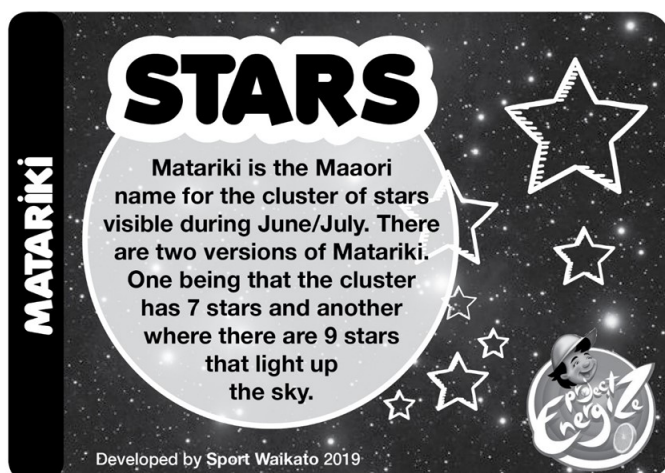
3. Thank you

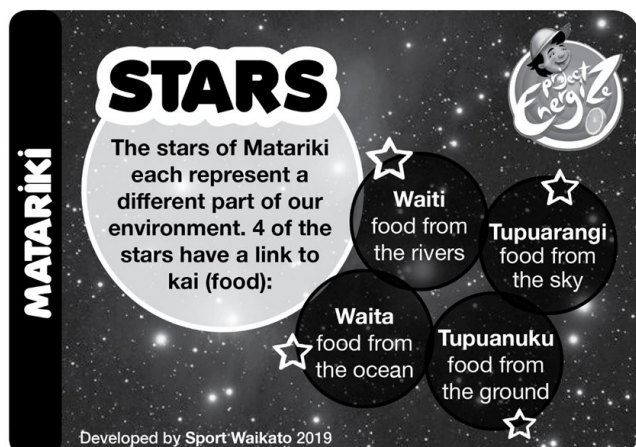

If anyone is interested in a position or belonging to the committee please come along. All welcome.



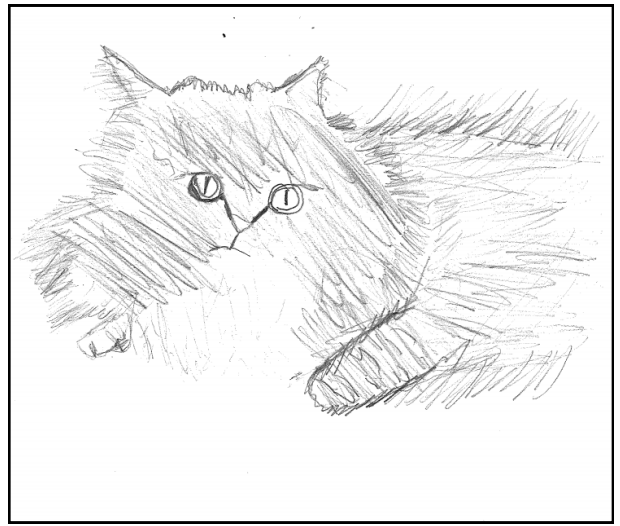
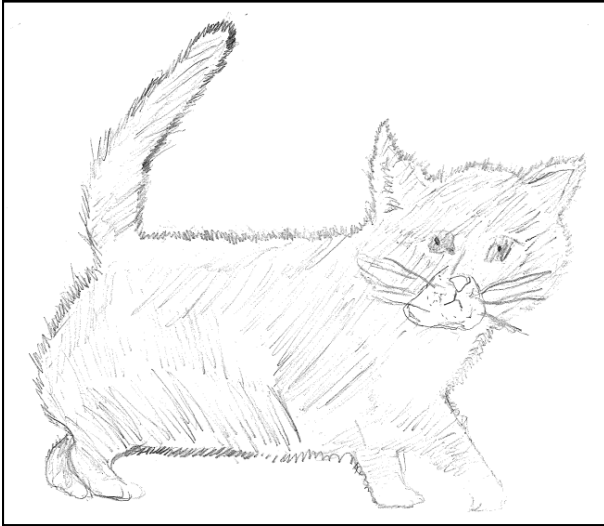
